The Building Assessment Committee is distributing a summary of their report on the buildings in Minden and Carnarvon and how they would fit into our vision of the future of the new Highland Hills United Church. This report, that records the capabilities and the shortfalls of each building, has not produced a clear decision of one building over another. A Question and Answer session will be held following the joint worship service at Minden on September 17 to provide you with an opportunity to ask questions and seek clarification from this committee after you have had an opportunity to study their summary.

Rather than a hard deadline for the decision about which building to use for worship, our approach continues to be one of taking a series of thoughtful, careful steps as we contemplate a choice which will be best for our future.
